Daniel Lloyd Risch, age 74 of Midland passed away at his home on Wednesday, March 8, 2023.

Daniel was born August 29, 1948 in Waukesha, Wisconsin the son of Arthur W. Risch and Dorothy B.(Engle) Risch. Daniel graduated from Bath High School in 1966. He then joined the United States Navy and served during the Vietnam War.
