Raymond "Ray" G. Windy, 92, of Reese, beloved husband, father, and grandfather passed away Friday, March 3, 2023, at his home in Reese. He spent his last days in his earthly body in the living room of the home that he built, surrounded by the family he created with the woman he called the "most beautiful girl he's ever seen". As he lay there listening, the family showered him

with all the love and affection they have for him. They played polka music for him and reminisced. His final hours were full of the ruckus of a full house made with laughter and love.

Ray was born August 22, 1930 in Cass City, to the late Josef and Theresa (Drewek) Windy. He attended Sand Valley School House. Ray proudly served his country during the Korean War with The United States Marine Corps.

Ray married the love of his life, the former Myra Volz, in Merrill in January of 1957. Together, they raised eleven children. He was employed as the Chief of Security for Steering Gear in Saginaw for many years until his retirement. He farmed the family homestead, was employed as the custodian for the church grounds, was sexton for the cemetery for St. Elizabeth Catholic Church for over 20 years, and had many other jobs.

He was a longtime member of St. Elizabeth's Catholic Church in Reese. He served on the board and finance committee of the St. Elizabeth Credit Union, the board for St. Elizabeth Catholic Cemetery, and was a Grand Knight of the Holy Trinity Assembly 2013 Knights of Columbus. Ray enjoyed spending time with his family, gardening, vacationing, and being outdoors.
